Request to Cameron Regional Medical Center's Key Stakeholders --- Assistance Needed with Community Health Needs Assessment Survey

Subject: Community Health Survey for Clinton, Caldwell, Daviess, and DeKalb Counties

Over the next three months, Cameron Regional Medical Center will be updating its 2016 Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA). This CHNA update will cover Clinton, DeKalb, Daviess and Caldwell Counties and is a follow-up process designed to meet final IRS regulations released in 2015. These regulations require all 501(c)3 hospitals to conduct a CHNA and adopt an implementation strategy at least once every three years.

The goal of this assessment update is to identify progress made since 2016 in addressing community health needs and to collect up-to-date community health perceptions. **In order to accomplish this goal, a short online survey has been developed and can be accessed at:** https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/CameronRegional_CHNA2019
